Job Description:

Dishwashers are responsible for unloading the dishes and cutlery brought to them by bussers and loading them into dish trays. The trays are then placed into the commercial washers and blasted with scalding hot water. The commercial dishwashing machines can't always accommodate larger pots and pans, so occasionally you may be required to wash things by hand, the old fashioned way. Dishwashers are almost always the last person to leave at night so be prepared for some late nights (especially on the weekends). Even after the last table has been served, the kitchen needs to be cleaned and the trash has to be emptied.

There is a large element of cleaning the kitchen and restaurant equipment. You will remove trash and garbage and place in the trash compactor, clean and hose out garbage cans. You will sweep and mop the kitchen floors. You will wash dishes, trays, pots and pans used in cooking and serving. You will help dining room staff by scraping food from plates and stacking them in the dishwasher. You will also need to clean coolers, kitchen tables, refrigerators and prep stations.

The shifts range from 7am - 1am 7 days per week. The schedule will be determined based on need for a 35-40 hour work week.

Description:

Housing options are generally shared accommodations. Many home owners will rent rooms in their house. Many times the rooms are shared with one other person. Edgartown is the town where the restaurant is, so anywhere in that town would be close to work. Otherwise, if housing was found in Vineyard Haven or Oak Bluffs, travel could be 45 minutes to 1 1/2 hrs. by bus depending on the location. I would suggest to look in these three towns only, as the others are much further to travel. Please reach out to your employer after being hired for housing assistance.

Transportation for Community Housing Description:

Students are encouraged to get bikes if they are not too far from the work site. There are many safe bike paths on the island. They could walk as well, if living in Edgartown center. Otherwise, the island bus system is quite efficient (Martha's Vineyard Transit Authority). The nearest bus stop from the work site is just a few blocks away. A yearly bus ticket is \$150.

ARRIVAL INFORMATION

Arrival Instructions:

You will want to take PETER PAN BUS (www.peterpanbus.com) from Boston Logan Airport (www.massport.com/logan-airport/) or South Station (www.south-station.net/regional-bus) to WOODS HOLE (the town where the ferry departs from - www.steamshipauthority.com). Travel time on the bus is about 2.5 hours. When you get to the Woods Hole ferry dock, the Peter Pan bus leaves you in front of the ferry terminal. Go inside and purchase a one-way passenger ticket (\$10.00 – to either Vineyard Haven or Oak Bluffs). Travel time on the ferry is about 45 minutes.

Before you get on the ferry, look for a white luggage cart that is pulled by a small engine. You can put your luggage on it before you board the ferry. (It will give you freedom to explore the ferry). Watch this video to learn more about the Steamship Authority youtu.be/vCWsKb1Wzk8.

When you get off the ferry, you can take a taxi (\$15 +) to Edgartown, or take either the #1 Edgartown-Vineyard Haven Road (most direct) or #13 Edgartown - Oak Bluffs - Vineyard Haven via Beach Road (most scenic) bus (<http://vineyardtransit.com>) to Edgartown. Bus will cost \$2.50-\$3.75. Annual passes can be purchased for \$150. It might sound expensive, but if you take the bus to and from work every day, the pass would pay for itself in one month! The Social Security Administration will travel to Martha's Vineyard once mid-May and once mid-June from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. at the Oak Bluffs Library to help students apply for their Social Security Card. Oak Bluffs Library 56R School St, Vineyard Haven, MA 02568 (508) 693-9433 oakbluffslibrary.org If the student does not arrive around the date that the Administration will be on the island, they will need to travel to the office in Falmouth, MA. Take ferry to Woods Hole and then Uber or taxi to 48 Research Rd, East Falmouth, MA 02536. This is about a 10-15 minute drive.

Employee must be in complete uniform at all times while in guest view. All male employees with beards or mustaches must keep them well

trimmed and at a reasonable length. Hair must be neatly cut, combed and not to exceed collar level. All female employees' hair must be neatly cut and pulled back from the face. Female employees may wear subtly styled earrings during service. Earrings are not to be worn by men during service. Visible body piercing, with the exception of earrings, is prohibited.

All requests for time off must be submitted in writing at least one week in advance. Switching shifts is permitted only with approval from management and must be documented and co-signed by management and both parties involved in the shift changes.
