The Bakehouse sits waterfront over looking Casco Bay. Beautiful sunsets & ocean views are available from the deck & inside store windows. The island is very busy with tourists, day trippers, and local sailing camp kids frequenting the store.

The Bakehouse is a family owned & operated small business, part take-out restaurant, part general store. We value quality food, hard work & fun. It offers ice cream, fresh baked goods from scratch, pizzas & sandwiches, beer & wine, lobster, take-home meals, and the islands only gas station. There is a fast-paced, fun work environment. ARRIVAL INFORMATION

Arrival Instructions:

There are two options for your travel to Portland Maine.

1) Boston Logan International Airport (BOS). Flying into Boston offers more flight options and is typically more affordable for students. We recommend that students fly into Boston Logan International Airport (BOS) and take a bus or train to Portland, Maine (approximate travel time 2-2.5 hours). The cost of a one-way bus or train ticket to Portland will be about \$30.00. The Concord Coach Bus

(https://concordcoachlines.com/) and the Amtrak Train Downeaster (http://amtrakdowneaster.com) both arrive at the Portland Transportation Center.

2) Portland International Airport (PWM). Flying directly into Portland.

Once in Portland, students will need to take a taxi (approximately \$25) to Casco Bay Lines Ferry Terminal at 56 Commercial St. (https://www.cascobaylines.com). Please plan accordingly for which ferry you will take to Long Island (approximately \$10). Ferry service runs from 6a - 9:30p daily. Once on island, a Bakehouse employee will drive you from the ferry to the house.
