It's true, Breckenridge is a small mountain town which means it incredibly easy to get around by foot or bike. Sidewalks are on almost every street, and pedestrian-friendly crosswalks are available on most blocks. Technically, you can walk from one side of town to the other in roughly 15 minutes.

If you're looking to go further than Breckenridge or are coming in for the day, the Summit Stage offers free public bus service throughout Summit County. This public transportation system connects Breckenridge with neighboring resorts of Keystone and Copper Mountain, as well as the towns of Silver
