Job Description:

Employees will be working in various roles throughout the restaurant. Duties include line cook, food prep, order takers and food runners.

Line Cook - Set up and stock food items and other necessary supplies in your station. Prep food by cutting, chopping, mixing, and breading these items. Fry and grill items to specified recipes and standards. Maintain cleanliness and complies with food sanitation requirements by properly handling food and ensuring correct storage. Clean and sanitizes cooking surfaces at the end of the shift.

Front Line Order Taker - Responsible for assisting customers with menu selection, recommendations, and taking accurate food orders in a friendly and hospitable manner. This role effectively keeps the flow of the restaurant moving smoothly by maintaining clear communication and teamwork.

Food Runner - The Food Runner is primarily responsible for delivering food orders from the kitchen to customers rapidly and accurately. It is this person who will maintain the cleanliness of the expo line, organization of order tickets, and communicate effectively with BOH team.

Prep Cook - Responsible for the preparation of ingredients and stations used in the cooking process, as well as maintaining the kitchen and

ensuring it is clean and sanitized.

Bartender - Work directly with customers by mixing and serving drink orders. Responsibilities include verifying age requirements, knowing alcohol pairing and tastes, knowing how to make traditional and classy drinks, processing payments, managing inventory and cleaning bar supplies.

Shifts vary from 10 - 4, 4-10 or 12-10.

If you arrive at Boston Logan Airport take the free Massport shuttle bus from any terminal to the Blue Line at Airport Station.

Take Blue Line train to State Street Station and transfer to the Orange Line to North Station for Commuter Rail service.

The commuter line train is the Amtrak Downeaster. Take this train from Boston North Station to Saco, ME (Saco Transportation Center).

An Uber or Lyft from the Saco Transportation Center to the house is only 10 minutes and costs approximately \$12.

If you arrive at Portland International Airport you can an Uber or Lyft from the airport to the house. It is a 25 minute ride and costs approximately \$35. You can also take a taxi from the Portland airport for around \$50. Please plan to tip drivers as it is customary based on level of service.
