ACCOMMODATION

UNIFORMS & GROOMING STANDARDS

Uniform

All employees may wear blue denim jeans, khakis, colored jeans, or slacks. No leggings or athleisure wear. All pants must be clean with no holes, fraying, tears, or rips. Uniform shirts will be issued by



Wardrobe for uniformed positions. You may request a uniform jacket and hat. Uniform pants may also be provided upon request.

Grooming Requirements

Hair: to be clean, neatly groomed, away from the face, and of "natural" colour. Hair is to be no longer than collar length or pulled back in a ponytail

Facial Hair: Must be trimmed (1") and maintained

Tattoos: Must be covered if larger than 2"

Earrings and facial piercing: 3 earrings per ear and plugs have to be smaller than ¼" and covered.
