Ranch Camp has a farm style housing unit adjacent the business. It shares a parking lot with the workplace. The unit sleeps can accommodate up to four students but is capped at three max. The unit is no co-ed. It has an open sleeping area, with beds, an adjacent area with storage, a table and chairs and a small area where food can be stored and prepared. It includes a refrigerator, microwave, cabinets and shelves. The unit also includes a large bathroom with a shower. Blankets, linens, and towels are included in the unit. Wifi is available as well.

TRAINING AND ONBOARDING

Pre-Arrival Onboarding: Yes

Students must read, understand and sign our J1 rules and regulations document that outlines rules in the workplace. This document will be submitted to students to sign via email and must be returned before arriving for work. We will review the same document upon arrival during in-person onboarding. The rules and regulations are defined in the company policies section below.

Students residing in staff housing must sign a lease in advance of arriving. Students must live in the leased housing for the time they are present and working. Rent is charged in one week increments concurrent with payroll timing (Monday to Sunday). Days will not be prorated if the apartment is occupied for a portion of a pay period.

Applicable Company Policies:

- *Lunch / breaks are unpaid. Break times are 60 minutes total per 8 hours worked, for a total shift duration of 9 hours. You must clock out during your lunch and break times*
- *One meal is comped per 8-hour shift worked, up to a \$15 retail value. Every other meal is discounted 50% while on the clock. If a shift is cut short and an employee works less than 8 hours, their meal will not be comped.*
- *Overtime will be granted only with permission from Chef Joe.*
- *Arriving at work and punching in prior to the scheduled time is not allowed unless approved by Chef Joe in advance.*
- *Any break or meal is not to be taken until staff have been working for at least 3 hours – arriving at work to punch in and eat lunch on the clock is not allowed under any circumstance.*
- *Complete closing duties and punch out no more than 1 hour after closing time unless requested to stay by Chef Joe or your direct supervisor- Shift coverage must be approved by Chef Joe or supervisor to avoid overtime.*
- *Staff will receive one complimentary shirt/ uniform per employee. All others may be purchased at cost.*
- *No work will be scheduled or performed after work visas expire*
- *Employees living in housing provided by the employer must stay in the housing for the duration of the work contract.*
- *Rent is charged in one week increments concurrent with payroll timing (Monday to Sunday). Days will not be prorated if the apartment is occupied for a portion of a pay period.*
