Each unit has 2 rooms. One is a bedroom with 2 beds and the other is a sitting area. Each unit has a bathroom with a shower. The units have functioning Fire Alarms, working locks, and appropriate emergency exits. Amenities include but not limited to refrigerator/freezer, beds with bedding/linen provided, microwave, range/oven, utensils, private bathrooms. Rent per month/student will cost \$400-\$500 (exact price to be confirmed soon)
