Weather in the summer ranges from 50 - 85 degrees. Days are typically sunny with some afternoon showers, so we encourage you bring a rain jacket or umbrella. Evenings and early mornings tend to be chilly.

# ARRIVAL INFORMATION

#### **Arrival Instructions:**

There are two options for your travel to Avon, CO. Denver International Airport offers more flight options and is typically more affordable for students. Eagle County Regional Airport is much closer to Avon, but has limited flights.

1. **Denver International Airport (DIA)** If you fly into DIA we suggest you take an Epic Mountain Express Shuttle to your residence. You must book your shuttle reservation at least 72 hours in advance. East West employees receive a 20% discount. Book online at https://www.epicmountainexpress.com/shuttle-rates.Enter the Promo/ Group Code: EWREMP, then Password: avalanche22. The cost is typically between \$62 and \$92. Travel time is 2.5 hours.

2. **Eagle Country Regional Airport (EGE)** EGE is located 30 minutes from Avon, CO. To get from EGE to your residence you can take the ECO Bus for \$4, or take a shuttle or taxi.
