Please keep track of all the items included with your bed, we will check that all are accounted for at the end of the summer. Suggested Travel Days and Times

To avoid heavy traffic, students should ideally plan to arrive Monday-Thursday between 12:00 pm and 8:00 pm. We understand that not all flights will be able to accommodate this schedule but be advised that transportation may be more expensive for late-night/early-morning arrivals and weekend flights can potentially add several hours to the arrival time.

PHL

Philadelphia International Airport is the closest airport terminal to Rehoboth. It may be difficult to find direct flights to Philadelphia but you can get a connecting flight that lands at PHL. This airport is roughly two hours from Rehoboth although this can change with traffic. There are two primary ways we recommend that you travel to Rehoboth from the airport. You may coordinate travel plans with a group (up to 5 people) and pay \$50.00 per person for transportation by your landlord or you may contact E-Point Student Travel Center which offers bus transportation for students for \$90 per person. In both cases, we recommend arranging travel as soon as possible but require a 3-week notice.

EWR

Newark Liberty International Airport is located in New Jersey and is an international hub for travel and most students should be able to find direct or connecting flights landing at EWR. It is roughly 3 - 3.5 hours away from Rehoboth though this can easily increase to 4 hours with traffic. You may coordinate travel plans with a group (up to 5 people) and pay \$80.00 per person for transportation by your landlord or you may contact E-Point Student Travel Center which offers bus transportation for students for \$100 per person. In both cases, we recommend arranging travel as soon as possible but require a 3-week notice.

JFK

John F. Kennedy International Airport is located in New York. All students should be able to find flights through JFK with little to no issues. The international airport is one of the busiest in the United States, and for this reason, we recommend traveling in groups. JFK is about 4 hours from Rehoboth but during rush hour this can increase to 5 or 6 hours. You may coordinate travel plans with a group (up to 5 people) and pay \$80.00 per person for transportation by your landlord or you may contact E-Point Student Travel Center which offers bus transportation for students for \$100 per person. In both cases, we recommend arranging travel as soon as possible but require a 3-week notice.

BWI

Baltimore Washington International Thurgood Marshall Airport is about 2 - 2.5 hours from Rehoboth. Students should be able to book direct or connecting flights through BWI. You may coordinate travel plans with a group (up to 5 people) and pay \$80.00 per person for transportation by your landlord or you may contact E-Point Student Travel Center which offers bus transportation for students for \$85 per person. In both cases, we recommend arranging travel as soon as possible but require a 3-week notice.

Rehoboth Sunsations and The Shirt Factory both have a casual dress code. We recommend wearing something you will be comfortable in all-day, specifically comfortable shoes. We issue each student a work t-shirt that is required for the uniform and you may wear appropriate pants or shorts. For men and women, we ask that any shorts reach the mid-thigh and do not have any rips in them (this will be elaborated on during orientation). Job Site Policies

We expect employees to be punctual and prepared for the day. Showing up on time is not only important to us as your employer but to your coworkers as well. Please bring everything you will need for an 8-hour shift (or the scheduled duration of your shift) there will not typically be opportunities to go home during the day. Cell phones should remain inside your bags in the stock room. They should not be seen while you are working (the same policy applies to headphones, vapes, and cigarettes). Day off requests should be submitted one week in advance in order to be considered.

We ask that you respect the house you will be staying in as if it were your own. Please respect your housemates and discussing bathroom schedules and quiet hours are suggested but not required. If there are any issues, please let your landlord know and if necessary, they will be able to help resolve any issues. Smoking is not allowed inside the house, if you choose to smoke please do so outside. This is for the care of the house and also for the respect of your housemates. We also ask that you are responsible for taking out the trash. It is collected on a weekly schedule if the trash is forgotten and you need an additional trash pick up, all housemates will split the cost.
